Nonsuch High School PTA is a member of PTA-UK, a nationwide organisation for providing advice and services to school Parent/Teacher associations. All trustees give their time voluntarily and receive no remuneration or other benefits.

Objectives and Activities

Summary of the objects of the charity set out in its governing document

To advance the education of the pupils in the School and in furtherance of this object the Association may:

- Develop more extended relationships between staff, parents/guardians and others associated with the School;
- Engage in activities that support the School and advance the education of pupils attending it;
- Provide and assist in the provision of facilities for education at the School (not normally provided by the Department of Education).

Summary of the main activities undertaken for public benefit in relation to these objects

- Raising funds to supplement and support the School's educational activities, through such events as sales of refreshments, preloved school uniforms and the 200 Club monthly draw.
- Providing logistical support for school activities and events and generally providing a link between the students' parents/carers and the teaching/governing body.

Achievements and Performance for the year

The Nonsuch High School PTA undertook a number of initiatives and events throughout the academic year to raise funds for the school as well as engage support from parents. These were met with positive feedback leading to another successful year in raising funds that were spent across a range of school led initiatives.

For the financial year 2023/24, the PTA ended the year with a net surplus on its Income and Expenditure account, of nearly £16,000, an increase on the previous year's results. Bank balances in the PTA accounts amounted to just under £30,000 at year end, broadly in line with the previous year and against the backdrop of being able to fully fund all school requests for funding — a reflection of the successful fundraising activities undertaken by the PTA. Some of the PTA activities and funding raising events for 2023/2024 are highlighted below:

200 Club Draws

The '200 Club' prize draw is a cornerstone activity in raising funds, and this year, we raised a net amount of just under £2,900.

<u>Preloved Uniform Sale</u>

The PTA Committee organised a Preloved Uniform Sale over the summer although it does try and sell as and when there is a demand. This year, sales generated a net surplus of just under £3,700.

Walking Event

In what is becoming another regular fund-raising activity on the PTA calendar; a sponsored walkathon by the PTA and parents raised close to £2,700 this academic year, with over £700 in matched funding raised – another brilliant effort!

Doughnut Sale

Always a firm favourite – especially with the students – this helped raise close to £1,300 in sale proceeds.

Raffles

This year the PTA organised a Christmas Raffle with numerous prizes on offer. This activity raised close to £2,300 in net funding.

Year 7 Welcome Event

This has now become a significant annual event in the PTA calendar allowing the new YR7 entrants to the School to have an early opportunity to meet each other ahead of starting their new adventure in senior school. They participated in a range of sporting activities such as football, cricket and hockey. This year the event raised over £1,700 in net funding.

Hiruki's Bike Ride

Inspired by a parents Walking challenge last year, a Year 7 student alongside her father and brother, decided to cycle from London to Paris covering 300km over 3 days. As part of that challenge, they also decided to raise funds for the school. As a result, they raised over £1,500 – a magnificent personal and funding achievement!

Funding towards School Activities

This year the PTA was once again able to fully fund all of the Schools funding requests, of over £16,500, that contributed towards supporting learning and for the well-being of the students. The funds raised were used to provide for the following:
